## ***National Incident Management System Incident Command System***

**IS700 – Introduction to the National Incident Management Systems (NIMS) and  
IS100 – Introduction to the Incident Command System (ICS)**

This brief (4 hour) training provides an overview of the systems that we will work under in disasters. These courses are required for government employees, volunteers and private sector partners that will work in emergency situations.
